## 2010 Ponies UK Summer National Showing Championships

**1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2010 Ponies UK Summer National Championships.**

Qualification cards will **NOT** be awarded in the ring / placings are sent to PUK by the Club.

**Qualification is open to P(UK) MEMBERS and NON MEMBERS of P(UK)**

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are **not** current members of P(UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. **The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1st July and 31st July must submit their membership within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid**

- All qualifying classes are run in accordance with Ponies UK 2010 Rule Book.
- **In Hand Qualifiers**:- any age, any height and mare, gelding or Stallion.
- **Ridden Qualifiers** horses/ponies to be 4 years old and over, mare or gelding with the exception of the Championships marked with an \* where Stallions are eligible. Riders any age unless otherwise stated on the individual classes.
- **M&M**:- all qualifiers must be registered with their approved respective breed society.

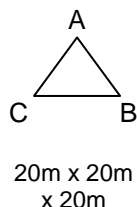

3. Lead rein classes are to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband only.
