Class 4	<b>Senior Intermediate</b>	Rider 18 years & over	<b>85cm (2'9")</b>
Class 5	<b>Open</b>	Rider Any Age	<b>1m (3'3")</b>
Class 6	<b>Pairs</b> (time & weather permitting)	Rider Any Age	<b>75cm (2'6")</b>

**THE COMPETITION WILL BE RUN ON AN OPTIMUM TIME BASIS**

### Notes, guidelines and rules:-

- All ages at 1st January in the current year.
- Competitors must be 4 years and over.
- Cross country is run in accordance with British Riding Club Official Rules.
- Horses/ponies can only enter two classes from 1 to 5 and the Pairs.
- All riders must wear protective headgear to EN1384 and PAS015 standard at all times when mounted.
- British standard back protectors are compulsory whilst on the cross country course. BETA approved is recommended.
- Jewellery must not be worn whilst on the cross country course.
- Stop watches are not permitted whilst on the cross country course.
- Prize money to fourth depending on number of entries.
- Rosettes to sixth in all classes.
- A refundable cash deposit of £2 is required on the day for competitor numbers.
- Competitors and spectators must abide by the Club Rules.
